1.4 Previous studies

They are discuss liberal feminism in victorian era reflected on Enola Holmes film, they uses descriptive qualitative methods and feminism liberal theory. The results of this analysis Enola Holmes fights for the rights as a woman within the scope of liberal feminism.

The last previous studies is an undergraduate thesis entitled Feminism In Enola Holmes Film: A Semiotic Lens (2022) written by Alfi Syahriyani. This research deals with the portrayal of feminism in the film of Enola Holmes in the era of 19th century through its main character 'Enola'. The film represents the feminist values through the character of Enola, such as independence, intellectual, showing freedom of choice, gender equality, and right to privacy.

The difference between previous studies and this research is that firstly, the writer finds three important things in the film Enola Holmes (2020) which focuses more on the extrinsic aspects, such as causes, effects, and values of liberal feminism reflected on Enola Holmes Film (2020). The first undergraduate thesis only focuses on the development of characterization in Enola Holmes.
