

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine and analyze the effect of transparency, accountability and participation on the management of Village Funds in Gemuh District, Kendal Regency. In order to realize improvements in the quality of village fund management and good governance.

The sample selection in this study using purposive sampling. The sample of this study was 320 people from 16 villages in Gemuh District, Kendal Regency with 7 village officials, 5 BPD people, 6 RT people and 2 RW people for each village and the amount of data processed was 310 respondent data because 10 questionnaires were used. redistributed not returned.

The results of this study indicate that simultaneously the variables of transparency, accountability and participation together have a significant effect on the management of village funds. Partially, the three independent variables, namely transparency, accountability and participation have a significant positive effect on the management of village funds.
