

ABSTRACT

This research aims to examine the effect of corporate governance, profitability, and capital structure on firm value with corporate social responsibility as an intervening variable in mining subsector energy companies. The independent variables in this study use corporate governance, profitability, and capital structure. While the dependent variable is firm value and the intervening variable uses corporate social responsibility.

The sample used in this study are mining sub-sector energy companies listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange in 2021-2023. The purposive sampling method was used as a sampling method with certain criteria with a total sample of 33 samples. The analysis used in this research is partial least square.

This research uses stakeholder theory to formulate hypotheses that lead to the results of the research analysis. The results showed that corporate governance and profitability have a positive effect on firm value, while capital structure and corporate social responsibility have a negative effect on firm value. The results also show that corporate governance has a negative effect on corporate social responsibility. However, profitability and capital structure have a positive effect on corporate social responsibility. For the results corporate social responsibility research as an intervening variable, it show that profitability and capital structure have a negative effect on firm value through corporate social responsibility. Meanwhile, corporate governance has a positive effect on firm value through corporate social responsibility.
