Additionally, in an academic context, this model of combining research and creative media production can serve as a learning resource that enhances students' technical and artistic abilities as well as their cultural awareness while fostering genuine contributions to the development of local tourism. In order to introduce Indonesia's cultural legacy to a larger audience, both domestically and abroad, it is anticipated that the integration of cinematic storytelling and tourism promotion would become increasingly ideal with continued development.
