

ABSTRACT

Human development is a measure of the progress of a country. The low quality of human resources is still a major problem in Indonesia. The quality of human resources in Indonesia can be seen from the Human Development Index. This study aims to analyze several factors that influence the Human Development Index in Indonesia. The human development index is the dependent variable, while government spending on education, education infrastructure, health infrastructure, and GRDP per capita are independent variables. In this study the data used was cross sectional data from 34 provinces in Indonesia. The analysis in this study uses multiple linear regression with OLS. From the results of the analysis of this study, it shows that there is a significant influence between government spending on education, health infrastructure and GRDP per capita on the human development index. While other variables, namely educational infrastructure, showed no significant effect.
