Saran saya untuk melakukan penelitian lebih lanjut, sangat penting untuk mengamati tidak hanya berdasarkan perdebatan yang ada. Perdebatan yang ada tersusun atas argumen yang menolak suatu norma dan argumen yang mendukung suatu norma. Maka dari itu sangat utama untuk memindahkan fokus pada ide umum dari suatu perdebatan. Ketika penelitian mengenai kriminalisasi internasional difokuskan kepada ide umum, hal ini akan membuat diskusi menjadi lebih luas dan terlihat perkembangan dari suatu norma secara signifikan. Kemudian, memiliki pemahaman bahwa suatu aktor bukanlah pembentuk norma secara mutlak. Namun, aktor sosial tersebut dibantu oleh aktor sosial lainnya dalam proses pengujian dari suatu norma.
