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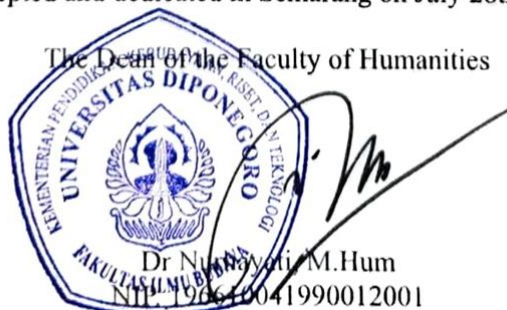

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ABSTRACT

Euphoria is a popular youth television series that aired from 2019 to 2022, featuring predominantly young characters. This series is significant for study because it extensively uses dysphemism in the dialogues of its youth characters. This research explores the types and functions of dysphemism employed by the main youth characters to identify the most commonly used dysphemism and their intended purposes. The data for this study is derived from the dialogue of the first season of the "Euphoria" television series, released in 2019. The author applies Allan and Burridge's classification of dysphemism functions (2006) and Rawson's classification of dysphemism types (1989). Data collection involves non-participant observation and documentation methods, while analysis utilizes context of each dialogue and the terms meaning. The findings reveal a total of 323 dysphemistic terms in the television series. In conclusion, the word "fucking" emerges as the most frequently used dysphemism, primarily serving to intensify or highlight something or a specific condition.
