ABSTRACT

The goal of this study is to examine the floutings of the Cooperative Principle that exists in the utterance of character in the movie, as well as to analyze the implicature generated by the maxim violations to determine the relationship between characters. The writer uses non-participant observation method in order to collect the data. The violation of the maxims generates implicature that the writer uses to examine the relationship between the characters involved. This results in 27 utterances that violates the cooperative principles. Maxim of Quantity was violated 12 times, maxim of Quality was violated 8 times, and maxim of Relevance was violated 6 times. The usage of violations of the maxims can result in patterns between how people relate one to another. Romantic relationships, familial bonds, and forced interaction are some of the relationships displayed through the implicatures generated.
