ABSTRACT

This study analyzes the main character namely Joe Johnson in the movie *Cowboys* by Anna Kerrigan. This study aims to explain the symptoms, social causes, and the effects of gender dysphoria in the social life of the character Joe Johnson. Library Research is used as a data collection method in this study. The writer uses an objective approach to analyze the intrinsic aspects in the movie. In addition, the writer uses a socio-psychological approach that is supported by the theory of gender dysphoria symptoms by the American Psychiatric Association and George R. Brown, the theory of social causes of gender dysphoria by M. Paz Galupo et al, and the effects of gender dysphoria theory by Di Ceglie et al to analyze the extrinsic aspects of the movie. The results of the analysis show that Joe Johnson shows all the symptoms of gender dysphoria which are influenced by his social environment. This also indicates that gender dysphoria affects Joe's social life in the form of bullying that he has to face.

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini menganalisis tokoh utama yaitu Joe Johnson dalam film berjudul *Cowboys* karya Anna Kerrigan. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menjelaskan gejala, aspek sosial yang mempengaruhi disforia gender, dan efek dari disforia gender dalam kehidupan sosial tokoh Joe Johnson. Studi Pustaka digunakan sebagai metode pengumpulan data dalam penelitian ini. Penulis menggunakan pendekatan objektif untuk menganalisis unsur intrinsik dalam film. Selain itu, penulis menggunakan pendekatan sosial-psikologi yang didukung oleh teori gejala disforia gender oleh American Psychiatric Association dan George R. Brown, teori pengaruh sosial dari disforia gender oleh M. Paz Galupo et al, dan teori efek disforia gender oleh Di Ceglie et al untuk menganalisis unsur ekstrinsik film. Hasil analisis menunjukkan bahwa Joe Johnson menunjukkan semua gejala disforia gender yang dipengaruhi oleh lingkungan sosialnya. Hal ini juga mengindikasikan bahwa disforia gender mempengaruhi kehidupan sosial Joe berupa *bullying* yang harus ia hadapi.
