

# ABSTRACT

The great recession 2008 had left a big damage to the American Society, especially in housing system. *Nomadland* (2020) depicted the social stratification as well as how the great recession affecting the life of the social system which is changing into a new social system of nomadic life. The aims of this research are

to explain the social change and to understand the components of social stratification in post 2008 great recession. The Talcott Parson's structural-functionalism and Max Weber's social stratification theories are implemented to examine the extrinsic aspects portrayed in this movie. The exponential and sociology of literature approaches are functioned to evaluate the data that has been compiled using the library research method. The result of this research shows that there is social change in the social system in post 2008 great recession, which is being perceived by Fern; Linda May; and Swankie, that shifted into nomadic life by living in vehicle home. In addition to that, the main result shows that in post 2008 great recession, the ownership of a 'house' is shifted to become one of the crucial components that makes the characters in this movie are being classified, that is into upper-middle class and working class.
