ABSTRACT

This study examines the personality structures, types of anxieties, and Defense mechanisms of Princess Diana. The writer analyzes how Princess Diana's household problems cause anxieties and how she overcomes them by using Sigmund and Anna Freud's psychoanalysis focuses on theory of personality structure, anxiety and Defense mechanism. To support the analysis, the writer uses other theories, such as theories of character & characterization, and conflict to cover the intrinsic elements. Library research is used as the research method of this study, while psychological approach is used to analyze the extrinsic elements. The results show that anxiety and Defense mechanism are reflected in Princess Diana in the movie *Spencer* (2021). Anxiety covers the anxiety of lateness, the anxiety of divorce, and the anxiety of losing custody. Defense mechanism covers rationalization of breaking into the Park House and divorcement, sublimation of sharing story, acting out by self-harm, and reaction formation of rebellion.
