ABSTRACT

This research focuses on the struggles of woman faced by Amy March and her sisters during the nineteenth-century American patriarchal society in the *Little Women* (2019) movie by Greta Gerwig. This research is intended to explain the representation of nineteenth-century American patriarchal society, its relation to class and gender, and how the character Amy March has to struggle within it. This research is carried out using a sociological approach. The library-research method is used to collect the data for the analysis. The writer applies the patriarchal society theory by Allan G. Johnson and the types of patriarchal society by Sylvia Walby to conduct the analysis. The discussion shows that Amy March, as a middle-class woman, experiences public patriarchy that forces her to follow society's expectations of women in order to achieve her dream and help her family's economy and status. In the analysis it is found that Amy March faces the struggles to be a painter, the struggles to fit in upper-class society, and the struggles to marry well.
