ABSTRACT

This study examines the politeness strategies employed by Annalise Keating, the main character in the series "How to Get Away With Murder" (HTGAWM) in her professional interactions. The study adopts descriptive qualitative research and utilizes Brown and Levinson's (1987) theory of politeness strategy as the theoretical framework. The research goal is to gain an understanding of the politeness strategies employed by Annalise Keating and how sociological factors, such as power, social distance, and rank of imposition influence her choice of strategies. The study reveals that Mrs. Keating primarily employs the bald on record strategy (46.7%), followed by negative politeness (30.32%) and off record (16.4%), while positive politeness is the least used strategy (6.55%). The analysis demonstrates that Mrs. Keating's choice of politeness strategies is influenced by sociological factors. For instance, she tends to use negative politeness strategies when interacting with individuals of higher power and social distance, such as judges.
