ABSTRACT

This study's purpose is to identify the trauma and the stages of grief of the male main character, Raleigh Becket, in *Pacific Rim* movie. The trauma and the stages of grief of the main character are analyzed based on the theory of trauma by Cathy Caruth and the five stages of grief theory by Elisabeth Kübler-Ross. To analyse the data, this research uses a library research method combined with movie watching and aims to identify the trauma and the stages of grief of the male main character. Psychological approach used in this study to examine how the main character's mind and behaviour operate based on the movie script. The relevant data collected for this study includes information from the movie *Pacific Rim*, books, and articles. The result of this research shows that the male main character experiences trauma and also experiences five stages of grief, namely denial, anger, bargaining, depression, and acceptance.
