

ABSTRACT

The Zakat Village Index is a mechanism used to measure the condition of a village to determine whether it is worthy or not worthy of being assisted with zakat funds. The aim of this research is to find out whether Mulyorejo Village is a village that is worthy of distributing productive zakat program funds.

This research is a type of exploratory research. Meanwhile, the approach used is a mixed methods research approach, namely combining qualitative and quantitative methods. Data was collected by direct survey, as well as interviews obtained from sources. Next, the data will be processed by calculating the Multi-Stage Weigh Index by multiplying the five components of the village zakat index.

The IDZ calculation results for Mulyorejo Village obtained a value of 0.704, this shows that the condition of the village is in good condition so it is not prioritized for assistance. The economic dimension has the lowest index value with a value of 0.48, this shows that the economic conditions in the village are quite good. Even though it is in the quite good category, it can still be considered for help. A productive zakat program that can help the economy in this village is developing community creativity, one of which is by making handicrafts from patchwork.
