

ABSTRAK

Seiring dengan pengembangan Hutan Mangrove Baros sebagai kawasan ekowisata di Kabupaten Bantul, Yogyakarta, penting untuk mempertimbangkan integrasi nilai-nilai budaya lokal dalam perancangan dan pengelolaan kawasan tersebut. Akomodasi di area Hutan Mangrove Baros saat ini dianggap kurang memadai karena tidak ada fasilitas penginapan di sekitar area wisata. Ketersediaan tempat menginap sangat penting untuk memastikan kenyamanan bagi pengunjung yang ingin tinggal lebih lama di lokasi tersebut. Perancangan Mangrove Eco Resort dengan pendekatan Arsitektur lokal, berfokus untuk memberikan pengalaman emosional serta memperkaya wawasan kebudayaan. Suasana resort yang mengutamakan keseimbangan antara manusia dengan lingkungan Hutan Mangrove dan penggunaan material alami diharapkan dapat memberikan kesan tenang, nyaman dan pengalaman relaksasi bagi wisatawan serta memperkaya pengalaman ekowisata sekaligus mendukung pelestarian warisan budaya.

ABSTRACT

Along with the development of Baros Mangrove Forest as an ecotourism area in Bantul Regency, Yogyakarta, it is important to consider the integration of local cultural values in the design and management of the area. Accommodation in the Baros Mangrove Forest area is currently considered inadequate because there are no lodging facilities around the tourist area. The availability of accommodation is very important to ensure comfort for visitors who want to stay longer at the location. Mangrove Eco Resort Design with a local architectural approach, focuses on providing an emotional experience and enriching cultural insights. The resort atmosphere that prioritizes the balance between humans and the Mangrove Forest environment and the use of natural materials is expected to provide a calm, comfortable and relaxing experience for tourists and enrich the ecotourism experience while supporting the preservation of cultural heritage as part of Nusantara Architecture.
