Thank you for participating the Korean Council Webinar Program on Japanese Military Sexual Slavery. If you are interested in the “comfort women” related studies and movements and want to learn more, we hope this list of resources can be of some help.

This list collects four categories of resources. “Audio/video resources” contains documentaries and videos on the history and struggle of Japan’s wartime sexual slavery victims. “Places to visit” lists museums, exhibits, and memorial sites around the world dedicated to the theme. If you want to learn about and get involved in ongoing actions and events, please refer to the “organizations to follow” list of international and local organizations that have been working to raise attention and solve the historical issue until today. The “online resources” provide access to a variety of digital archives and special websites on the “comfort women” issue, where you can find primary materials and documentary evidence as well as academic research and non-academic publications on the Japanese military sexual slavery system during WWII.

However, this is in no way an exhaustive list. Studies on Japan’s wartime sexual violence during WWII cover the areas of history and memory, law and justice, politics and international relations, war and peace, gender and society, and so much more. Through our webinar series and this list, we hope to encourage you to start your own exploration and find your own way of getting involved.
