ABSTRACT

This study aims to explore the process of how Blasius Sudarsono extract his personal knowledge in writing Cerita tentang Pustakawan dan Kepustakawanan. Research method used in this research is qualitative research. Data was collected using semi-structured interview with Blasius Sudarsono and then being analyzed using thematic analysis. The thematic analysis result shows two main themes including Blasius Sudarsono's personal knowledge and its extraction process in writing his newest book entitled Cerita tentang Pustakawan dan Kepustakawanan. The personal knowledge extraction had done using personal knowledge management (PKM) framework developed by Avery, Brooks, Brown, Dorsey and O'Conner (2001). This framework steps including information retrieval, evaluating information, organizing information, collaborating around information, analyzing information, providing information, and the last is securing information. Blasius Sudarsono acquired his personal knowledge from his Javanese family culture, formal education in physics and library science, professional experience of being a librarian in Pusat Dokumentasi dan Informasi Ilmiah-Lembaga Ilmu Pengetahuan Indonesia (PDII-LIPI), and self-learning about philosophy field. Blasius Sudarsono had done the personal knowledge extraction process by doing PKM steps to write his book Cerita tentang Pustakawan dan Kepustakawanan, but skip the step of collaborating around information.
